- Undertake technical and tactical profiling as necessary to inform the preparation of players for fixtures.
- Deliver best practice performance analysis to targeted improvements.
- Deliver performance analysis service provision at training and fixtures.
- Collaborate on the development and implementation of the strategic vision, service concepts and resource management for performance analysis within Preston North End FC.
- Develop and facilitate appropriate communication methods. To inform and educate players, coaches and management in the effective use of performance analysis.
- Manage the data collected to facilitate its use by players, coaches and support staff.
- Maintain a comprehensive, indexed database of work conducted with players and coaches to prepare reports for line managers within agreed timescales.
